



About the CSLP

Established in 1988 and based at Concordia University, the Centre for the Study of Learning and Performance (CSLP) is a research centre with over 40 full members, research collaborators and associates, 20 support staff, and hundreds of graduate students. Researchers are from Concordia University, McGill University, Bishop's University, l'Université de Sherbrooke, Université Laval, Université du Québec à Montréal (UQAM), Dawson College, Leading English Education and Resource Network (LEARN), the English-Montreal School Board (EMSB), and Commission Scolaire Wilfrid Laurier (CSWL).

The CSLP has four main objectives:

1. To increase the theoretical and practical understanding of the factors that promote and hinder the learning and performance of complex skills.
2. To provide training and support to educators and administrators.
3. To provide the educational community with material and intellectual resources regarding new ideas in education.
4. To train students enrolled in graduate studies from affiliated departments in learning and performance.

We continue to emphasize basic and applied research and encourage various ways in which to disseminate our findings. We publish our results in peer-reviewed journals and speak at scholarly conferences. We communicate with partners via our Executive Board, our website, social media channels, and through activities such as our professional development institutes and research fairs. Students are an integral part of these activities.
