It was suggested that although provided for information purposes, in the future providing a copy of the previous version would be useful for comparison purposes.

Following a request to specifically mention part-time faculty members as individuals who can supervise students under section 1.1 of both guidelines, Dr. Aghdam noted that he was willing to look into this issue.
