Guidelines

Those wishing to present a paper are asked to send a 250-300 word abstract, while those proposing a poster should send a summary of approximately 100 words. The deadline for both is no later than December 31st, 2017. Please specify the format of the presentation (PowerPoint, video, etc.). Applicants must include their name, school, year, and phone number, so that the assessment committee can contact them. Applicants will be informed of the result of their submission by January 10th 2018. If chosen, completed papers should be sent to conuirishsociety@gmail.com by January 20th, 2018.
