The main goal of this discussion and workshop is to bridge the gap between Concordia researchers, government agencies, and local NGOs. We want to find better ways to work together to address the issues of urban sprawl and its consequences. Each participant will briefly present how their current work is related, or is affected by, urban sprawl. These short presentations will foster a productive discussion about the issue and help identify potential areas for future collaboration to better address urban sprawl. Through their presentations, the participants will together create a mind map — a drawing created around a central concept (i.e., urban sprawl) illustrated as an image in the center of a blank page, to which associations to other ideas are added, e.g., other images or words. The mind map will be used to identify the connections between urban sprawl and the presenters' practical work and research.
