Professor Aman Ullah is currently Distinguished Professor of Economics and Chair in the Department of Economics, University of California, Riverside.

He has held previous positions at SMU, Dallas and University of Western Ontario, Canada. Among many prestigious universities and Institutes, that he has visited include, ANU, Monash, NSW, Canterbury(NZ), Cambridge, Amsterdam, Tinbergen Institute, FGV (Brazil), CIDE (Italy), Goethe (Frankfurt), CORE, Xiamen, Peking, SMU(Singapore) Bilkent, Stanford, McGill, and World Bank among others.

His main research interests are in Econometric Theory, Nonparametric Econometrics, Finite Sample Econometrics, Cross Sectional and Time Series Econometrics, and Panel and Spatial Econometrics. Prof. Ullah is the author, coauthor, editor, or coeditor of eight books and over 120 published papers in Economics, Econometrics, and Statistics. He is an elected fellow of the Journal of Econometrics and National Academy of Sciences (India), as well as that of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) Fellow; he is also honoured as an Associate Fellow of CIREQ, Montreal and Senior Fellow of the Rimini Centre for Economic Analysis, Italy.
