CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

Fellowships and Awards Administered by Concordia University Institute for Canadian Jewish Studies 2017-2018

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: May 1, 2017

Many of the awards are available in the area of Jewish Studies generally, and many are renewable. Please read each description carefully. Application Instructions follow the descriptions.

Mahlab Fellowships are awarded through competition to full-time students entering or pursuing a course of study leading to a Masters/Magisterial or PhD degree at Concordia University. Eligible candidates must be pursuing research in the area of <u>Jewish Studies</u>. Preference may be given to students pursuing research in the area of <u>antisemitism and its roots</u> or <u>Canadian Jewish Studies</u>. Awards are tenable within the first three years of a Master's/Magisterial Program or the first five years of a Doctoral Program. This award is subject to Concordia's Regulations on Holding Multiple Awards Simultaneously. These fellowships are renewable once and are valued at approximately **\$7,500**.

Moses Montefiore Fellows Graduate Scholarships are granted to full-time students entering or pursuing a course of study leading to a Masters/Magisterial or PhD degree in the in the area of <u>Jewish Studies</u> at Concordia University. Applicants may be Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or international students. The Awards may be renewable so long as the recipient continues to meet the terms and conditions. The scholarships are valued at approximately **\$7000**.

Miriam Aaron Roland Fellowship will be awarded to a candidate pursuing graduate or postdoctoral research in the areas of <u>Canadian Jewish Studies</u> or <u>Jewish Studies</u> at Concordia University. The fellowship is valued at **\$5,000**.

Romek Hornstein Memorial Fellowships are awarded to full-time Master's/Magisterial and Doctoral students whose research is in the field of <u>Jewish Studies</u> at Concordia University. The purpose of the fellowships is to help students of academic merit and promise who, without such assistance, would be unable to pursue graduate studies. Selection will be made on the basis of academic merit. Financial need may be considered but is not necessary. Two fellowships will be awarded annually to one male and one female student. These fellowships are non-renewable. They are tenable within the first three years of a Master's/Magisterial or the first five years of a PhD Program. This award is subject to Concordia's Regulations on Holding Multiple Awards Simultaneously. The fellowships are valued at \$3500.

The Harris and Ann Wetstein Foundation Graduate Scholarship is open to all students whose research is in the area of <u>Canadian Jewish Studies</u> at Concordia University. It is tenable within the first three years of a Master's/Magisterial or the first five years of a Doctoral Program. This award is subject to Concordia's Regulations on Holding Multiple Awards Simultaneously. The scholarship is valued at \$1500.

Kanfi-Holzbauer Award will be granted, based on academic merit, to deserving Master's/Magisterial or Ph.D. students, Postdoctoral Fellows or Research Associates at Concordia University, to cover conference travel expenses or research travel expenses related to <u>Jewish Studies</u> or <u>Canadian Jewish Studies</u>. Applicants must demonstrate that the goal of their trip is to attend a conference, pursue research, or attend meetings relevant to their studies/research. Preference will be granted to candidates who have demonstrated that the Award is essential to their travels and that their trip is important to their studies/research. The Award may be used to reimburse any type of expense related to the trip. Reimbursements will be issued by the School of Graduate Studies upon submission by the awardees of appropriate receipts. The award is valued at \$1000.

Application Instructions: all applicants must submit three (3) copies of the following (one of the three copies should be an electronic e-mail attachment [pdf] addressed to: ira.robinson@concordia.ca and the other two should be hard copies addressed to Ira Robinson at the Department of Religion):

- 1) Application form (see below). To apply for the Romek-Hornstein award as well, please also submit the additional application form required (see below).
- 2) Official transcripts of all university studies.
- 2) An up-to-date curriculum vitae, including a list of publications and relevant professional and research experience.
- 3) A statement of purpose. In order to give the adjudication committee an idea of who you are and intend to be as a scholar, please indicate the work you have done in your program and your plan of study for the upcoming academic year, a short description of proposed research for thesis or capstone project and (if you are not a PhD student) for future (graduate) research. If relevant, please describe proposed research travel. In addition, you should highlight your accomplishments in research, particularly as they relate to your current and intended scholarship. A budget is not necessary; rather clarity of research purpose and of goals in the funded year are of interest to the committee. (Maximum 750 words).
- 5) Two letters of recommendation from past professors or professional mentors.
