1) Writings by Karl Polanyi, 1907-1978

The series consists of articles, draft articles, papers, prefaces, addresses, manuscripts, and draft manuscripts. The writings are in Hungarian, German and English. Part of the series contains articles and draft articles written in Hungary and Vienna (1886-1933), mainly published in the journals *Sazabadgondolat*, and *Huszadik Század*, as well as in *Bésci Magyar Ujság* and *Der Oesterreichische Volkswirt*. Karl Polanyi's interest in the social sciences is documented in an earlier large hand-written unpublished manuscript in German. In the mid 1950's Karl Polanyi wrote an extensive draft manuscript that was never published on economic anthropology and the economic history of Greece. Karl Polanyi's and his wife Ilona involvement in the Hungarian Council in Great Britain is documented in a series of draft articles and correspondence. Part of Karl Polanyi's writings include drafts for *The Great Transformation*, "Christian Left Bulletins", "Europe To-Day", *Trade and Market in the Early Empires: Economies in History and Theory*, a draft manuscript of the *Livelihood of Man*, posthumously edited by H. W. Pearson, and a draft manuscript and notes, which posthumously became *Dahomey and the Slave Trade*. *An Analysis of an Archaic Economy*. (1957).

The Writings by Karl Polanyi can be divided into the following groups:

Articles, review articles, draft articles, addresses, and prefaces in Hungarian and German, written mostly in Hungary and Vienna, 1907-1933.

Also included are some English translations by Karl Polanyi, as well as later translations by Ilona Duczynska done in the 1970's, and Kari Polanyi Levitt done in the 1990's.
