The Feminist University Seminar out of the Simone de Beauvoir Institute is looking to hire a part-time Research Assistant to coordinate and supervise a student-led collaboration between the Feminist University Seminar and the Sir George Williams Affair Commemoration Committee. This position will be supervised by Dr. Kimberley Manning (Simone de Beauvoir Institute) and Dr. Nalini Mohabir (Geography) and will primarily provide curatorial guidance to 2-3 students from the Feminist University Seminar for a library exhibition. Collective tasks will include book and archival selection, contextualization of sensitive archival materials, production of descriptive labels and digital display, and copyright determinations. This position will also include attending the Feminist University Seminar.

- Must be available for approximately 5 hours of work/week
