- 1) **A letter outlining the purpose of the request.**
- 2) **An abstract (max. 250 words) of the proposed conference paper and a copy of registration or proof of acceptance to the conference.**
- 3) **A CV**
- 4) **A copy of student transcripts.**
- 5) **Your financial needs (travel budget), including a statement of other sources of funding.**
