## **Highwater Foundation Scholarship for Student Veterans**

This scholarship was established in 2017 by Stephen Hurlburt, President of the Highwater Foundation. He is a long-time Concordia University donor and a graduate of JMSB with a BComm '71.

The purpose of the Highwater Foundation Scholarship for Student Veterans is to recognize and reward academic excellence in veterans of the Canadian Armed Forces, as well as those who are currently serving, who are enrolled in full-time studies at Concordia University.

This non-renewable In-Course Scholarship is open to full-time Bachelor's students in second year or higher, in any discipline of study. Candidates must:

- Be registered full-time in Fall/Winter 2019-2020 in any Bachelor's program discipline
- Have an Assessment GPA of at least 3.30
- Provide proof of veteran status or current service (see below)
- Provide a written overview of their veteran status or current service

In addition to the written overview of veteran status or current service, candidates wishing to be considered for this scholarship must provide legible proof of <u>at least one</u> of the following:

- CFOne card with Veteran or CAF designation
- NDI-75/CF-75 card
- National Defence temporary ID (laminate)
- National Defence NDI-20 card (CFID)
- Record of Service document
- Canadian Forces Decoration (CD)
- An official DND memo on letterhead with a service number and name
- Veterans license plate issued by a Provincial vehicle authority (i.e.: MTO, SAAQ)
- Veterans Affairs official correspondence on letterhead (including either a CSDN, file, or service number
- Blue Cross health ID card for DND or VAC
- Service Canada Record of Employment (ROE) from DND with Service number (civilian employee ROEs not accepted)
- Royal Canadian Legion membership with Veteran status, Any Military ID issued by a US Government authority (DOD)

Application Deadline: September 30, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.

Award Value: 2 Awards - \$2,500 each
