Nawaf Al-Rufaie Scholarship in Communication Studies

This scholarship for full-time students in Communication Studies was established in 2006 in memory of Nawaf Al-Rufaie, by his family. The Nawaf Al-Rufaie Al-Rufaie Scholarship in Communication Studies is intended to encourage and reward talented Communication Studies students at Concordia University who exemplify the characteristics of Nawaf Al-Rufaie, BA Communication Studies 2004.

Candidates are required to submit with their application form an essay describing their enthusiasm, dedication, generosity, and passion for learning in the area of Communication Studies. Essays must be scholarly in nature, and 500 words in length.

Students applying for this scholarship must:

- Be in their second year of studies (or higher)
- Be enrolled full-time in Fall 2019 and Winter 2020
- Assessment GPA for 2018-2019 of at least 3.30

This scholarship competition is open to Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents and International Students. The scholarship is not renewable however recipients may apply to be considered again in subsequent years.

Essay submissions must include a cover sheet bearing the title, "Nawaf Al-Rufaie Scholarship Competition", along with the candidate's name and I.D. number. If you have a **Co-Curricular Record** at Concordia University, feel free to include a copy with your submission along with the other supporting documents described above.
