- How do these experiences help add diversity to the classroom experience?

Essays must address all of the above questions in a scholarly fashion. Essay submissions must include an application form, and a cover sheet bearing the title, "Pariso Scholarship Essay Competition". If you have a **Co-Curricular Record** at Concordia University, feel free to include a copy with your submission along with the other supporting documents described above.
