Robert V. Tucker Memorial Award

The Robert V. Tucker Memorial Award is intended to encourage and reward promising full-time students who have taken a non-traditional educational path to reach their current status in the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science program, with a Specialization in Actuarial Mathematics. Candidates for this award must be in second year or higher, and must also demonstrate the intention of pursuing a career in Actuarial Mathematics, and a dedicated work ethic and willingness to help others in need.

Eligibility Criteria

Program: Bachelor of Arts, Specialization Actuarial Mathematics

or

Bachelor of Science, Specialization Actuarial Mathematics

Status: Full-time Fall 2019 and Winter 2020

Citizenship: Open to Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, and International Students

GPA: Minimum Assessment GPA of 3.00 required

Award Value: 1 Award valued at \$1,700.00

Applicant's Essay

Qualified students who wish to be considered for this award must submit a 500-word essay explaining their non-traditional or traditional educational path (e.g. previously studied in another unrelated discipline, or in another Mathematics or science discipline) that led them to studies in Actuarial Mathematics.

Candidates must detail how their world experience has contributed to their current appreciation of their educational opportunities, career goals, and motivation in Actuarial Mathematics. Essays will be judged on content, as well as the quality of the applicant's reasoning and written expression of ideas.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: September 30, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.

Students wishing to be considered for this award must submit their application form and required essay no later than the above deadline.
