## EMERGENCIES AT CONCORDIA BE INFORMED, GET CONNECTED

If an emergency arises on campus, do you know what to do? If you require immediate assistance on campus call **Security at (514) 848-3717 or ext. 3717** from an institutional phone. Security dispatchers will connect you directly to emergency services where necessary, while coordinating the response and saving valuable time.

## Here are a few steps you can take as a Concordia student to prepare for an emergency:

- 1. Sign up for the Emergencies at Concordia What You Need to Know training, in person or online. Learn more at **concordia.ca/emergency**.
- 2. Get the Rave Guardian app on Google Play Store or Apple App Store for emergency alerts on your cell phone or mobile device.
- 3. Download the Alertus computer application in the MyConcordia portal (under Software and Applications) to receive pop-up emergency alerts.
- 4. Add campus Security (514 848-3717) to your contact list.
- 5. Visit **concordia.ca/emergency** to review emergency procedures and more.
- Become a first responder by joining Concordia Emergency Response Team (CERT).

**Important:** If you, or someone you are with has reduced mobility during a building evacuation, use the red fire phone (located next to the emergency stairwell) to notify Security of your location.
