POSITION OVERVIEW

YMCAs of Québec day camps offer fun activities that are both physically and intellectually stimulating. The Y has long been recognized for its youth and child development programs. The YMCA-Concordia Fine Arts camp combines Concordia's Fine Arts expertise with the YMCAs of Québec's long camp tradition to allow kids to immerse themselves in the arts and discover new modes of expression and creation. The various programs offered are in fines arts, theater, dance & music, for young people from 5 to 17 years old.

Reporting to the Camp Coordinator team, our Specialized Fines Arts Counsellors work with children aging from 5 to 17. They deliver a fun and safe camp experience through the planning and animation of age appropriate fines arts-oriented programming. They participate in the full life of camp as well as establish and maintain positive relationships with the children, parents and the camp team.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- You will plans, coordinate and animates fun and age appropriate specialized programming for his/her group in collaboration with his/her co Counsellor.
- Ensures that children are safely supervised at all times and that the camp environment is always safe, secure and clean.
- You will work towards building team spirit across the different groups of youth who attend camp activities.
- You will regularly communicate with parents and answer their inquiries in a prompt and courteous manner to develop and maintain positive relationships with them and their children.
- You will assist and participate in all camp preparatory meetings and training sessions, including weekly camp meetings and welcome calls.
- You will adhere to the YMCA's policies and procedures on the protection of children and vulnerable adults.

- In progress or completion of a university degree in a related field of study (Dance, Fines arts, Music, Arts Education, Child Development, Education, Leisure Studies, Psychology)(an asset)
- You must be proficient in French and English.
- You must not have a criminal record in connection with employment.
- Being a student or alumi of the Concordia Fine Arts Faculty (an asset)
