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Canadian Space
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What do we want to achieve?

- TRUST
- Communications that are consistent, regular, formal, yet flexible
- Common understanding of our collective capabilities and requirements
- Information to inspire students; awareness of space
- Identification of innovation
- Understanding of international implications (trade, legal, etc.)
- Breath of communication - inclusiveness
- Common understanding of point B (long term) to support planning
- Clear communication of GoC prioritization criteria
- Understanding of what cannot be lived with, what cannot be lived without, and who is accountable to whom and who is accountable for what

- Topic specific and classified forums
- Domestic team Canada missions (“trade missions”)
- Social media
- Industry Day (open to academia)
- National Sector Team for Space
- Formal committee structure
