Applications for Teaching Assistants (tutor, lab demonstrator, POD and marker) positions for the Fall 2019 semester will open on Tuesday, July 9, 2019.

Please select work assignments that are of interest to you and that are scheduled at times when you are available. Note that you must be available for work from the start of the contract date to the end of the contract date.

The deadline for application is Wednesday, July 31, 2019, with the below exception:

• Mechanical, Industrial & Aerospace Engineering: Friday, July 19, 2019

Necessary Qualifications

1. COPTTA

If you have not already done so in a past semester, you are required to complete the COPTTA English test taking place on Thursday, August 1, 2019; Wednesday, August 14, 2019; Friday, August 23, 2019; and Friday, August 30, 2019. Please consult with your Department for more details. Note that it is important to attend scheduled COPTTA appointments; and to notify us if you have to cancel and reschedule.

2. *Health and Safety*

To be qualified to hold a TA position as a tutorial leader or as a laboratory demonstrator, you must attend a one-hour Health and Safety workshop offered by GRADPROSKILLS if you have not already done so in a previous semester.

We are asking students to arrive 15 minutes prior to the workshop to give sufficient time to sign in. All workshops will begin on time. We remind students that GRADPROSKILLS is quite strict on punctuality; and if students do not show up on time or leave the workshop early, they are assumed to be absent and will be charged the non-attendance fee of \$25.
