PROGRAM STRUCTURE

- Three-week, online introduction, initiation and discussions.
- Six-day intensive in-person classroom component; leadership will be analyzed from different perspectives on organizational, managerial and team levels. Leadership as a basis for transformation, innovation and change will also be discussed.
- One-week recess.
- Four-week online session built on the issues addressed in the classroom week and mainly focused on problem-based activities (individual and group assignments).
