

CPA: List of Qualifying Courses

Applicants to the Diploma in Chartered Professional Accountancy (CPA) program must have completed a Bachelor degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00/4.30, or the equivalent. In addition, applicants must complete the 14 prerequisite courses listed below with a minimum grade of B- in each of the courses. Applicants may repeat these courses in order to achieve the minimum B-grade, but candidates with the fewest number of repeated courses will have the strongest chance for admission.

Please note that due to the competitive nature of this program, meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.
