- GMAT score of 550 or better (GMAT not necessary if one has already passed CFA Level 1)
- Letter explaining your commitment to the program
- Two letters of recommendation from business or academic professionals
- If applicable, we require a satisfactory TOEFL or IELTS score.

ENTRANCE SUPPORT PROGRAM

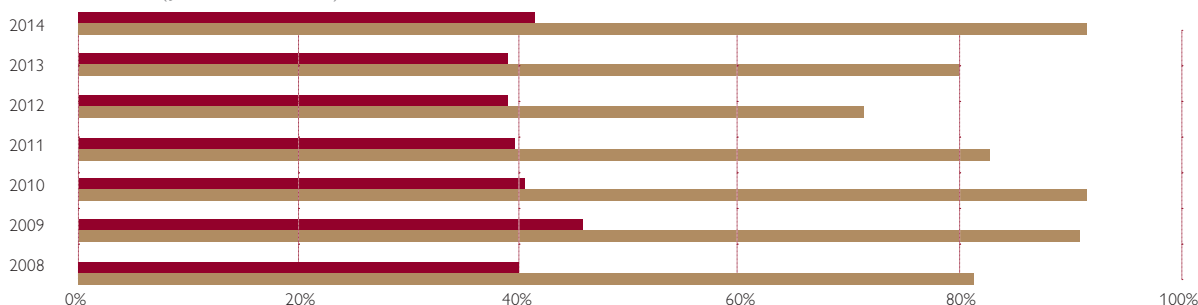

APPLICATIONS

We strongly suggest international applicants to submit their full application by March 1 to allow sufficient time for processing of government issued study permits for International Students.
