CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

Participants in the Master of Science (MSc) and Doctoral (PhD) programs at JMSB are invited to present their original research to the academic and business communities. The purpose of the exposition is to showcase the type and scope of research done at the JMSB and to help students achieve recognition, obtain feedback, and enhance their chances of success in academia or industry. The exposition uses a "Poster" format where excellence of research and presentation are top priority. Winners of cash prizes for "Best Posters" at each of the MSc and PhD levels will be determined by independent judges, most of whom come from the Montreal business community.

ELIGIBILITY

- Presenters must be current students or recent graduates (Fall 2017 / Spring 2018).
- · Posters can be based on theses, thesis proposals or project reports from research-based seminars.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- Send an extended abstract (500-600 words) of your research for review (see concordia.ca/agre for submission guidelines).
- Create a poster: content and appearance must be interesting, professional, and appealing to a broad audience. We provide advice and cover the cost of printing the posters.
- · Participate on the day of the Exposition and communicate your ideas personally to interested parties and judges.
- Compete for best-poster prizes.
