Description	The Science Exposed image contest challenges research groups or individuals to tell science stories through vibrant and exciting images. This is your chance to showcase your work and your creativity to provide Canadians with a whole new perspective on science. Contestants must have created the images in the context of their research. Images must be directly related to the contestant's research. Images can relate to any field of study: natural sciences and engineering, social sciences and humanities, or health sciences, with the exception of images from the arts, including visual arts, media arts, and research/creation. Images may be enhanced or modified, but changes to the image must not alter its meaning. In order to clarify or highlight elements of the image, colorization and graphic processing of images using software such as Photoshop© are permitted to clarify or accenture the content, but these changes must not misrepresent the content.
