

PRE-SELECTION APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND CHECKLIST

For applicants:

- ✓ Prepare all the relevant required documents (table below) and send them as one PDF document to your nominating department by July 31st.
- ✓ Ask your references to send their letters of recommendation directly to your nominating department.

For your application to be admissible, all required supporting documents must be included:

- 1- Completed pre-selection application form,
- 2- A photocopy of your passport or other official proof of citizenship,
- 3- Transcripts for all university studies, whether completed or not (certificate, diploma, Baccalaureate, Master's, Doctorate, etc.). In cases where equivalencies have been granted for courses taken in other institutions or prior programs, transcripts must be provided. In cases where transcripts are from outside North America, the candidate must enclose a letter explaining the grading system used in the educational institution concerned,
- 4- The two letters of reference sent directly from the referees to the nominating department,
- 5- Acknowledgements of receipt from the editor for all articles submitted and the editor's comments. Note that acknowledgements of receipt are not required for published articles.

For Nominating Departments:

- ✓ Verify each candidate's pre-selection application is complete.
- ✓ Complete the nomination submission form and use it as the cover page for each candidate's nomination package.
- ✓ Send each candidate's nomination as a single PDF document to the Graduate Awards Office no later than August 13th.

Only one PDF document per candidate will be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be forwarded to the internal adjudication committee for review.


