

Change of Concentration process

The following are procedures for students who wish to *'change their concentration to'* or *'add a'*:

- **MINOR, MAJOR OR SPECIALIZATION HUMAN RELATIONS**
- **MAJOR OR SPECIALIZATION RECREATION AND LEISURE STUDIES**
- **SPECIALIZATION THERAPEUTIC RECREATION**

Note: Change of Concentration from a BA to another BA, and to add a minor in Human Relations; this is a free process:

REQUIREMENTS:

Students **MUST** have at least a minimum of 24 Concordia credits completed with a Cumulative G.P.A. of 2.70 (Human Relations or Therapeutic Recreation) and a CGPA of 2.0 for Recreation and Leisure Studies.

1. A letter of intent (maximum 2 pages), which should cover the following areas:

- Program you wish to enter.
- Reason for your choice.
- How does the program relate to your learning goals and your career goals?
- List of previous and current work/volunteer experience that might qualify you for this program.
- If you think any element of your academic record is not reflective of your true potential, please explain.

2. A [Change of Concentration Form](#) completed and signed. This form must be filled in and PDF'ed with your letter of intent to alison.piela@concordia.ca

Note: Incomplete application packages will not be considered!

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

- **March 1** – FOR THE FALL SEMESTER
- **November 1** – FOR THE WINTER SEMESTER

- APPLICATIONS are not PROCESSED for the SUMMER SEMESTER.
