| 4. Translator must be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident residing in Canada. The translation must be into English or French. | > Submissions for the literary awards MUST include three (3) copies of the book. |
| 5. Film must be submitted on DVD/NTSC in English or French. Director and/or Producer must be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident residing in Canada. The film must be produced in Canada. | > Submissions for the Film Award MUST include two (2) copies of the film. |
| 6. Presented to a Montreal educator who has made an outstanding contribution to Jewish formal or informal education.
