**Adult Education and Indigenous Peoples**

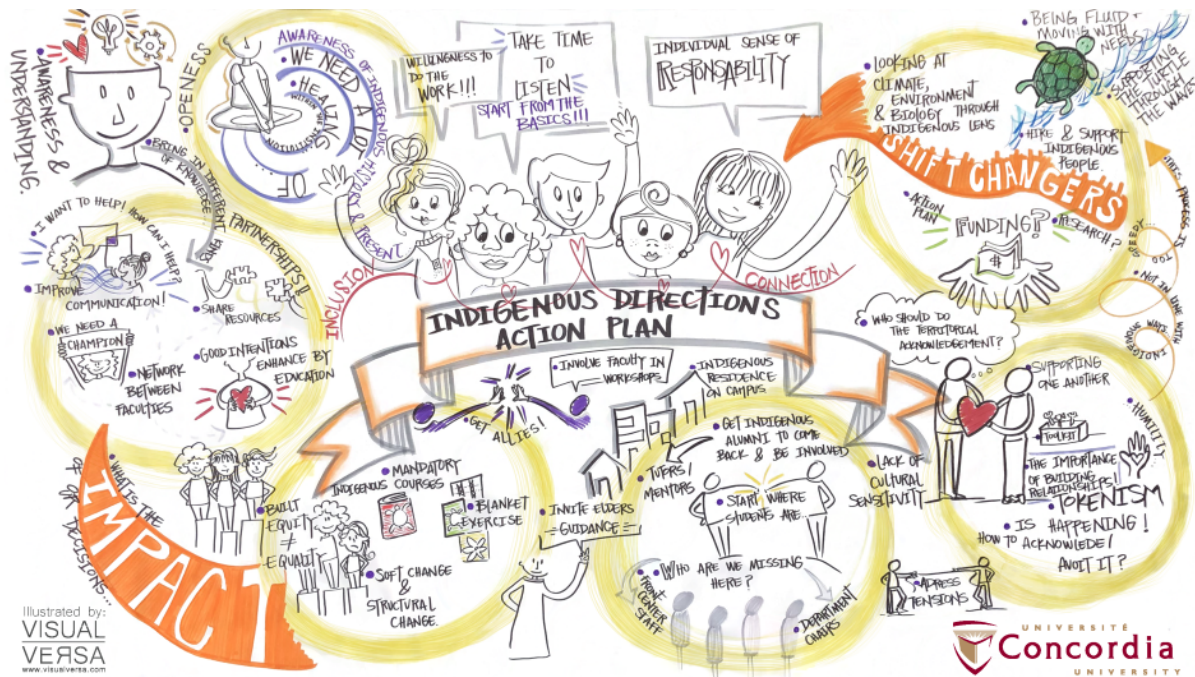
- Teacher Education Programs and Indigenous Education
