- 3. **The minimum requirements** for consideration to apply to Honours are:
 - a. 24 credits completed at Concordia, with a minimum of 18 PSYC credits at the 300/400 level.
 - b. A PSYC GPA of at least 3.7 for Psychology courses excluding 200 level courses.
 - c. A cumulative GPA (CGPA) and assessment GPA (AGPA) of at least 3.30.
 - d. NO grade lower than a C.
 - e. Normally at least 30 credits remaining to complete the minimum program requirements.
 - f. Refer to section 31.250 of the <u>undergraduate calendar</u> to review the program requirements.
- 4. The **deadline** to submit the application is at the end of the term, **[January 30, May 30, September 30]** with the previous term's final grades included.
- 5. Applications are reviewed, by the Honours Advisor, but final decisions are made by the Faculty of Arts and Science at least a month following departmental approval.
- 6. **In submitting this application, I agree that if accepted,** I will abide by the academic regulations currently in effect in the Undergraduate Calendar, or as may come into effect, with respect to maintaining my status as an Honours candidate. I understand that failure to maintain the requirements for Honours candidates will necessitate my withdrawal from the Honors program. Furthermore, I understand that I will not graduate with Honours unless I maintain the minimum GPAs as specified above.
