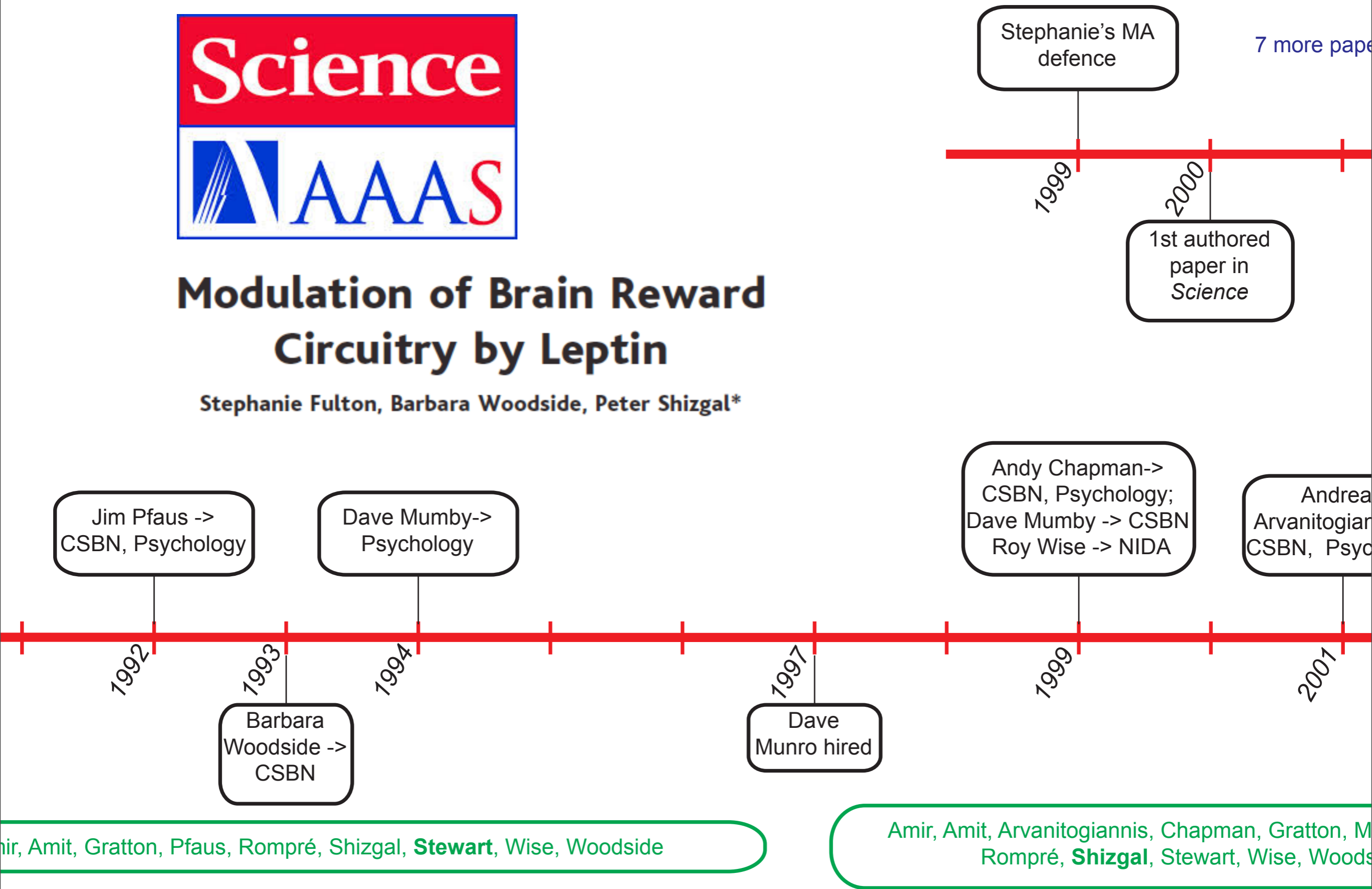


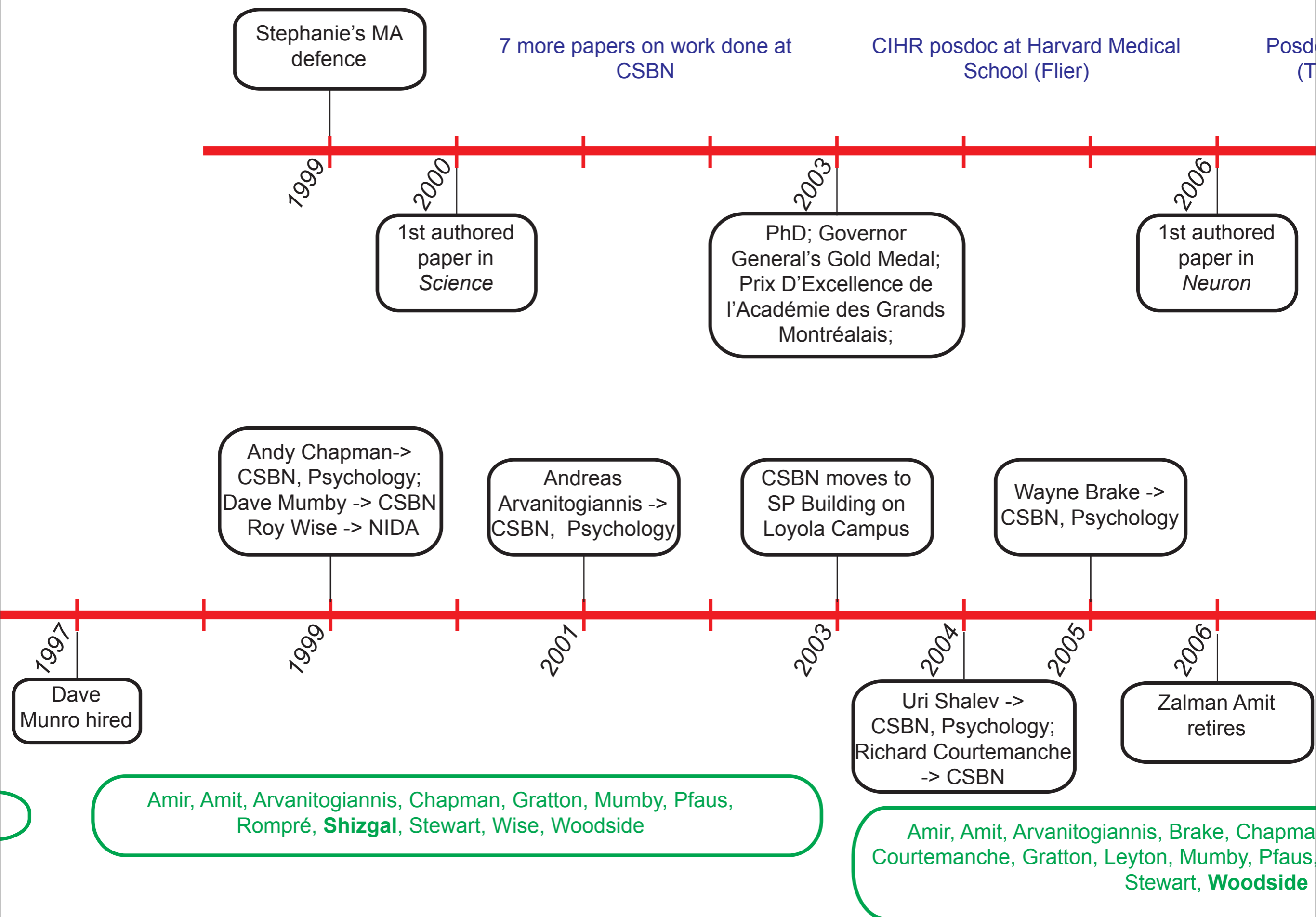




Modulation of Brain Reward Circuitry by Leptin

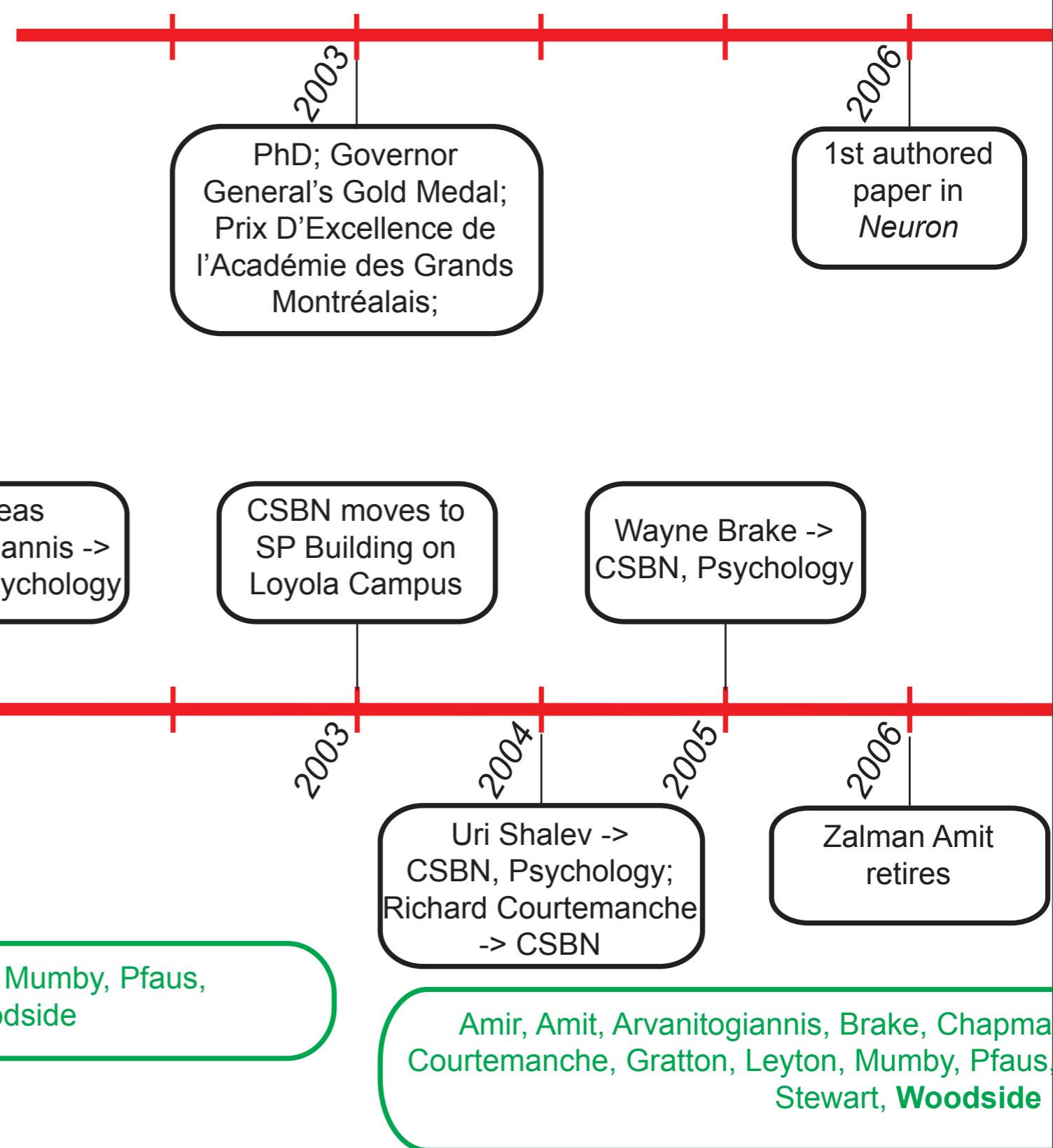


Leptin Regulation of the Mesoaccumbens Dopamine Pathway
