The Learning Toolkit+ (LTK+) team at the Centre for the Study of Learning and Performance (CSLP) research centre at Concordia University, has developed non-commercial interactive web-based educational tools. The [LTK+](#) is a suite of five, evidence-based and evidence-proven bilingual tools which are made available to the educational community at no charge. Used in learning environments around the world, these tools teach learners specific skills (e.g. reading and writing, information literacy, numeracy) as well as how to become self directed learners.

Position Description

We are currently looking for a part-time **Developer** to conduct a feasibility study on the use of AI tools to conduct backend updates (e.g. PHP, MySQL etc) on the **LTK+ literacy tools** (ABRA Lite and READS).

Qualifications

- Minimum Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Software Engineering, Computation Arts, Hypermedia technology, or related field
- PHP and MySQL web integration and programming.
- Prior experience with programming of the tools within the LTK+
- Good understanding of current AI programming applications

Assets:

- Experience working with Concordia's IITS support team
- Understanding of LTK+ servers setup

Specific responsibilities:

- Investigation and short-listing of the current AI programming applications that could be used to conduct the necessary backend updates for ABRA Lite and READS, and the creation of an installer for ABRA Lite
- Testing of the short-listed AI tools on sample LTK+ code
- Comparative analysis of the short-listed AI applications
- Final recommendations that include: feasibility, required development personnel, timeline, cost, etc
