SOCIO-SANITARY HYPOTHESIS – Wellbeing, prevention and treatment

- LEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING OFFERING
 - number of gamblers
 - number of at-risk gamblers
 - pambling-related problems



CONTEXT

SOCIO-ECONOMIC HYPOTHESIS – Taxation and revenus

- LEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING OFFERING
 - Illegal online gambling
 - secure and trustful offering



MANDATE

JUNE, 2010 - Establishment of an Online Gambling Working Group

- 1. Social impact of Quebec legal online gambling offering;
- 2. Regulatory, technical, economic and legal measures to counter illegal gambling.







Findings

- Online gambling is marginal : 1.3% in 2009 1.4% in 2012
 - Not often, not much, not long;
- Treatment services are available; service utilization is low;
- Prevention Focused on pathology Shame and harm to others;
- Role of State monopoly in prevention? Opposing messaging between prevention and promotional strategies.




Recommendations

- Redefine Loto-Quebec corporate social responsibility
 management of gambling offerings;
- Create and mandate an independent regulatory body (advertisement; offerings; security; integrity of games);
- Adjustment of prevention messaging risk of stigmatizing gamblers



Feedback loops





Results

- No channelling of offer
 - Besides Espacejeux, still 2,000 unregulated sites available;
 - 75% of online gamblers played on unregulated sites;
 - Unregulated sites are more accessible and popular;
- Revenus 20.5 M\$ (2011/12) 31.6 M\$ (2012/2013);
- Supervision and control of State monopoly practices should be entrusted with independent body?



Recommendations


- Take necessary actions to amend the criminal code;
- Continuous tracking and monitoring of online gambling.



SOCIO-ECONOMIC LOOP






Looping effect The creation of a category
