ONLINE GAMBLING PATTERNS IN FRANCE

Gambling Patterns and Problems of Gamblers on Licensed and Unlicensed Sites in France, written by J.M. Costes, S. Kairouz, V. Eroukmanoff, and E. Monson, was published in the Journal of Gambling Studies. This article aims to assess differences in gambling patterns and related harm between online gamblers who use licensed versus unlicensed sites.

ADDICTION PREVALENCE AND USE OF SERVICES

The article <u>Prévalence et utilisation des services dans le do-</u> maine de la consommation des substances psychoactives et <u>du jeu de hasard et d'argent</u>, written by A.N. Ngui, S. Kairouz, L. Nadeau and M.-J. Fleury, was published in *Le Point en administration de la santé et des services sociaux.* The article describes prevalence and determinants of gambling and drug consumption, as well as social and health services use.
