FRQ-SC PROJECT REPORT ON CYBER ADDICTION AND GAMBLING

Dr. Magali Dufour recently published a <u>research report</u> for her project on cyber addiction and gambling, funded by the Fonds de recherche du Québec—Société et culture (FRQ - SC) Concerted Actions program titled Socioeconomic impacts of gambling (in French only).

GAMBLING IN QUEBEC IN 2018

A new study published by the government of Quebec highlights gambling participation statistics in 2018 in Quebec. Two in three adults in Quebec participate in at least one type of gambling activity. Online gambling participation is trending upward while the region of Montreal has proportionately fewer players than the rest of Quebec. Consult the <u>publication</u> for more details.
