E-GAMES SURVEY

E-GAMES (Electronic Gam(bl)ing: Multinational Empirical Surveys Project) survey will be launched in November 2020 to collect data from Canadian gamblers and gamers in their habits and practices. Taking the pandemic into consideration, this survey will investigate the time and resources participants invested into their games of choice, as well as the effect of confinement on these practices.

THE IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 SHUTDOWN ON GAMBLING IN AUSTRALIA

<u>The Gambling Treatment and Research Clinic</u> released the preliminary results on their first wave cross-sectional survey. Roughly three-quarters of the participants in their study reported having gambled less frequently during confinement. However, many of the participants indicated that they expected to gamble more post-confinement.
