NEWS FROM THE GAMBLING FIELD

THE EMERGING IMPACT OF COVID-19

The <u>Responsible Gambling Council (RGC)</u> released a report on the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on gambling in the Canadian province of Ontario. On March 17th, 2020, the Ontario government restricted recreation businesses including gambling facilities. This report evaluates how community outreach and prevention programmes should be improved in the province.

BLOCKCHAIN AND THE DIGITAL ECONOMY

<u>In this book</u> written by Fred Steinmetz, Lennart Ante, Ingo Fiedler, an overview of the concepts of blockchain technology and the machinations of different blockchain ecosystems are presented. The book explores the socio-economic impacts and challenges regarding blockchain technology adoption, roll out, scalability and regulation.

GREA: "JEU D'ARGENT SUR INTERNET EN SUISSE" REPORT

<u>A study</u> carried out by GREA and Addiction Suisse revealed major challenges in the evolution of online gambling. The study draws attention to the dangers associated with the merging of video games and gambling.

HARM REDUCTION FOR GAMBLING: A PUBLIC HEALTH APPROACH

<u>This edited volume</u> aims to facilitate the evolution of the new public health approach towards gambling. Bringing together the work of international experts, it gives a current overview of the field, highlighting the need for a coordinated framework of prevention and harm reduction measures to replace current "player protection" measures.
