NEWS FROM THE GAMBLING FIELD

In his new book, *It's All about the Land: Collected Talks and Interviews on Indigenous Resurgence*, Taiaiake Alfred, a renowned Kahnawà:ke Mohawk activist and scholar, emphasizes Indigenous Resurgence as a means of contesting and combatting new and ongoing forms of colonization through a political agenda deeply rooted in ancestral spirit, Indigenous knowledge and laws. **See more here**.

A <u>report</u> by the <u>Victorian Responsible Gambling Association</u> examines marketing strategies used by sports betting brands on social media, such as Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram and their ability to engage and target youth.

This <u>report</u> by the <u>Institute of Public Health</u> presents data from Irish secondary school a that found 16-year-old boys are now at greater risk of gambling for money than the previous year.

Recent figures from the **Economic & Social Research Institute** provided the first estimates of problem gambling in Ireland. It indicated that problem gambling was far more prevalent than previously believed. The report is the first of its kind to reveal the true scale of problem gambling in Ireland.
