Co-directed by Professors Annie-Claude Savard, Sylvia Kairouz, Martin French, and Mélina Bouffard, this book examines the gambling landscape of Quebec and beyond. Through critical and multidisciplinary approaches, this book reflects on the question of responsibility in a society marked by neoliberalism, medialization, and individualization. It aims to deconstruct and challenge the dominant discourse of individual responsibility and advocates for a collective approach.



We also invite you to listen to the podcast [Dose de science en dépendances, épisode 6 : La dépendance : une responsabilité partagée](#). This episode discusses how addiction cannot be understood as an individual matter but develops at the intersection of several factors. It encourages a nuanced perspective on addiction that recognizes how stigma can reinforce shame, silence, and isolation, thereby hindering recovery.
