



## Doctoral Fellowship on Gambling - 2026-2027

The Research Chair on Gambling, funded by the FRQ-SC and the Fondation Mise sur toi, offers an annual fellowship at the doctoral level. **This fellowship seeks to encourage graduate research in the field of gambling under the aegis of the Research Chair.** The Chair's research program includes the following priority thematic areas:

- Gambling. 1) Population studies on social and commercial determinants of gambling; 2) Critical analysis of gender and gambling;
- Online Gambling: 1) Critical development of prevention algorithms; 2) Critical analysis of prevention messages;
- Gamification and hybridization of gambling, including the study of mobile connected games.

Candidates may submit projects related to these or other topics connected to gambling, provided that these projects take a critical sociological or public health perspective

### ELIGIBILITY

Candidates must hold a Master's degree and be full-time students who have been admitted into a doctoral program. First year Ph.D. students will be given priority. Candidates must be supervised or co-supervised by Dr. Sylvia Kairouz, holder of a researcher affiliated with the Research Chair on Gambling. International candidates are responsible for obtaining the proper documents for their stay in Québec.

### VALUE

The value of the fellowship is **\$30,000** and may be combined with any other source of funding

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Candidates must submit the following:

- Letter of interest (2 pages) stating the reasons for applying for a fellowship at the Research Chair;
- Research proposal (2 pages) in the field of gambling, elaborating on the research project, expected outcomes and deliverables;
- Official transcripts;
- Curriculum vitae;
- Doctoral program proof of registration;
- Two reference letters.
