



Undergraduate Research Internship - 2026

Concordia University's Research Chair on Gambling, funded by the FRQ-SC and the Fondation Mise sur toi, offers a **short-term undergraduate internship** lasting 1 to 3 months on a project related to gambling.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates must be registered full-time or have been admitted to an undergraduate Bachelor's degree program. Candidates must be supervised or co-supervised by Dr. Sylvia Kairouz, holder of the Research Chair in Gambling Studies. International candidates are responsible for obtaining the necessary documentation for their stay in Quebec.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Candidates must submit the following:

- Letter of interest (1 page) stating the reasons for applying for an internship at the Research Chair;
- Unofficial transcripts;
- Curriculum vitae;
- One reference letter.
