BUILDING FOOD SOVEREIGN CAMPUSES: A CASE STUDY

What's wrong with multinational university food corporations? What can we do about it? Dr. Chevrier will present the findings from his thesis, *Building Food Sovereign Campuses: A Case Study of the Campus-Community Food Organizations at Concordia University*. He argues that universities should go beyond notions of sustainability and develop food sovereignty approaches to campus foodservices. He discusses the successes and failures of food activism at Concordia, and presents a framework for distinguishing corporate, soft-sustainability and food sovereignty.

Erik Chevrier is a researcher, professor and community activist with extensive knowledge about food systems, ecological economics and social enterprises.
