** As of 2011-2012 SOCI 310 has been reduced from 6 credits to 3 credits. Students who have completed SOCI 310 as a 6 credit course must only complete 12 -300 level SOCI electives.

Apart from the 60 credits that are required for the Specialization in Sociology, the remaining credits to complete your degree are elective credits. The number of these elective credits will vary depending on whether you are in a 90, 108 or 120 credit program. Of these elective credits, 24 credits MUST be taken outside of the department. This is what is known as the 24 credit rule. Within these 24 elective credits, you will need to fulfill the General Education Requirements. You will need to complete either 6 or 12 credits (depending on the year you were admitted) of General Education courses. Please consult section 31.004 of the Undergraduate Calendar for more information.
