Amount: up to \$250.00

Application: Please submit the following documents to the Cary Boucock Memorial Award, Department of Sociology and Anthropology, H-1125-44, Concordia University, 1455 de Maisonneuve Blvd. W., Montreal, QC, H3G 1M8:

- 1) **a letter outlining the purpose of the request;**
- 2) **an abstract (max. 250 words) of the proposed conference paper and a copy of your invitation to participate in the conference;**
- 3) **a copy of your student transcript.**
- 4) **financial need, including a statement of other sources of funding.**

The due date for applications is announced in the Winter semester; awards are announced approximated two weeks after applications are due (and before the end of the Winter semester).
