Field Log: Wednesday, March 18th, 1998 Afternoon:

-Tumbler Ridge itself is off the highway through to Monkman Provincial Park.

-Drove into Tumbler Ridge and toured around to orient myself.

-As I was driving in on the highway between Chetwynd and Tumbler Ridge, I was stopped by Highway Patrol because they thought my muffier was too loud... something I hadn't noticed myself. I was told later that Highway Patrol comes from out of town and often stops people on very minor infractions.

-Bullmoose mine is on the north side of Tumbler Ridge (TR)

-Quintette mine is on the south side of TR toward Monkman Park

-Just south of the Bullmoose turnoff, the road and trees are black

due to coal transport to the rail stop

-There is a large campground open year round just outside of TR

-All services are in the downtown area; neighborhoods surround the area.

-There are two gas stations; gas prices are more that five cents per litre more expensive than in Chetwynd

-The townsite including the neighborhoods are very well planned; there are sidewalks and ample lighting on all the streets. According to locals, there is less than a 15 minute walk to downtown f om any neighborhood in town -Downtown architecture is very new, matched, and brightly colored; seems almost like a resort town

-Interview with ambulance attendant, Patti Nixon, at her home (Wednesday evening) -Ambulance service is inefficient, air ambulance doesn't work in the winter, one hour drive to nearest hospital

-Lost four EMA2's due to volunteers moving out of town, now down to one; have four EMA1's and one EMA2. Health centre in Tumbler Ridge is a diagnostic and treatment centre, so EMA2's are necessary; however, policy has changed this year to up EMA1's abilities to EMA2 level. -EMA Training sessions are expensive as equipment is shipped up f om Vancouver every time there is a training session. Training personnel are from both Vancouver and North. Training sessions alternate between towns, so one time it may be in Tumbler Ridge and another in Mackenzie

-Every year, the municipality, first aid staff from the mines, ambulance and health personnel plan a "mock" disaster to keep up their training. Often, highschool seniors volunteer as victims. -Ambulance service is mainly volunteer; employees are paid when they are called out. Some ambulance attendants have alternated on-call and work out of town on oil rigs, and other work sites for a more steady income.

-Most ambulance attendants are women

-Spoke with Quintette Union office. Future uncertain as Quintette's contract is finished and the first 276 layoffs will occur on May 1st.

Friday, March 20th, 1998

-Drove out to Quintette Mine (15 minute drive south of Tumbler Ridge)

-Spoke with the administrative assistant and received pamphlets and brochures.

-Mine will most definitely close down within the next two years, layoffs throughout this year and only support personnel and administration will be left.

-Interview with Colleen Hoopel, Family Support Society

-Provide Family Courlsellirlg, Parental Counselling/Parenting Seminars, Youth Counselling, Temporary Shelters, free of charge

-Noted a large problem with youth drug abuse (cocaine & marijuana) and with alcoholism in general in town

-Interview with Levonne Christensen, Women's Safe House Program

-Women go to them usually through the police, RCMP very cooperative there and town is set up so that RCMP response time is very short to domestic abuse calls.

-They have three families that take in women/children for up to five days as a place to stay

-If situation requires a safe home/shelter, women are driven to Dawson Creek shelter as Tumbler Ridge is too small to have a shelter

-Most women end up at the shelter and then end up retuming to Tumbler Ridge back to relationship or to an apartment

-Spoke with Health Centre Personnel (administrative assistant to Physicians and office administrator for Health Centre)

-Feels that health centre is very short staffed...have lost a nurse in January due to cutbacks and nurses are now run off their feet

-Physicians take leave in the summer to return to South Africa at which point locums are brought in, sometimes female

-Drove to Bullmoose Mine, spoke with "Dave" who gave me a mine tour and some pamphlets -Said that many administrative employees commute from Dawson Creek and are not too concerned with Bullmoose layoffs next year (Bullmoose will be shutting down in 1999 as their contract is up as well)

-Other factors in mine closures are that Bullmoose cannot compete with Asian prices and that coal reserves are running out.

-Bullmoose mine is smaller than Quintette

-There is a concern that when Quintette closes down this year, the train will no longer run through Tumbler Ridge to service Bullmoose as it isn't economically viable.
