Notes: surrounded by agricultural land, very rolling landscape, very picturesque, old farm houses and buildings, old rail fences still in use and being restored, welcome signs at north, south and west side of town, lake front park, public boat launch, number of bridges in town, sidewalks throughout.

Met with Joanne Henderson in Brighton at the OMAFRA office at 1:30. She was very friendly and eager to help with the NRE project. Provided a number of documents concerning Tweed. Note: Tweed has recently amalgamated with three rural townships, significantly increasing its land base.

Position of Centroid:

Information from Chamber of Commerce: There is no Chamber of Commerce in the Town of Tweed. Some business interests have organized a Business Improvement Area. Attempts were made to gather the information for sections 7.2, 7.3, 7.4 and 7.5 from the Deputy Clerk, the Reeve and the County Planner. A visit was also made to one of the alleged members of the BIA, and he was not in. None of my contacts had this detailed information.

History of Business Growth:

Strong woodworking presence, pallet plant, 2 veneer plants and craftsmen. Tweed Steelworks factory historically built bathtubs, gas pumps, fireplace liners - has downsized
 Ontario Powderworks Company closed just prior to the outbreak of WW1. Construction of a fire tower, potato chip and cheese factory provided numerous jobs until employers left town. Small businesses now predominate. Many turning towards tourism such as Quinn's Historical Store, Annabelle's Tea Room, art galleries and other crafters

Expectations for the Future:

It is anticipated that Tweed will capitalize on the growing tourism draw. Ample heritage and environmental features combined with relatively close proximity to Belleville, Oshawa, Peterborough, Kingston, Ottawa, Toronto and the United States.

Degree of Optimism Perceived: Reeve, Doug Mumford:

The predominance of small businesses is a volatile situation, always unstable
 Provincial downloading makes it difficult for the town to promote business
 Need to expand and replace aging water/sewer infrastructure for future development
 "Tourism and agriculture will be our two main industries"
 Continued role as a bedroom community because of development along Highway 401

Joanne Henderson, OMAFRA:

Tweed will "continue to be a hub for local activity". Do not anticipate large industry locating in Tweed. Could capitalize on natural amenities and the arts through tourism.

Paul Walsh, Hastings County:
