My primary points of contact into the community were gained through the Town Hall and I concentrated on the local, regional, provincial and federal officials for the more structured interviews. This was augmented by informal conversations throughout the community and the outlying region.

Initial telephone contact with Town Hall produced reluctance to participate in the research, however there were no real problems with access to the community or to the information.

In this instance I used the fact that my father had been born 40 km south on the same Bay to help familiarize myself.

4.1 - SITE HISTORY

The area around Winterton was most likely the site of Beothuk settlement long before Europeans first visited. The first recorded European visit to the area was John Guy in 1612.

The first census was taken in 1675 and recorded 3 planters, 40 servants and 8 boats. These settlers were West Country English fishermen from Dorset and Devon. Many surnames of the area originate from migration from this area in the late 17th and 18th centuries.

Winterton was originally called Scilly Cove, after the Scilly Isles off Southwestern England.

Negative impressions of the area because of the sound of this name ("silly" cove) prompted the name to be changed to Winterton in 1912, after Sir James Winter, a former Prime Minister of Newfoundland.

The area was the site of several French raids in the late 17th century. Following the signing of the Treaty of Utrecht, hostilities ceased and settlement increased. In the early part of the 20th century the population reached over 1100 people. Although the harbour is neither deep nor large enough for schooners, the abundant fishing in the surrounding area and the area's reputation for boat building made it popular for settlement.

In 1952 Winterton received resettlement from the north side of Trinity Bay.

The Town was incorporated in 1964.

In 1966 water and sewage were installed.

1997 was Town of Winterton "Come Home Year". It encouraged families and descendants to return to the area for celebrations.

Degree of Optimism Perceived: There is not a great deal of optimism in the area. Out migration is perceived as a major problem, particularly since the cod moratorium of 1992. Although 1996 Census information does not agree, local perception is that 80% of the population is retirees and all young people are leaving. The only answer given for the area is amalgamation of the small towns in the area to consolidate services. The whole area is said to be very depressed.

Halibut farming in the area is seen as a potential economic bonus but a very small employment opportunity.

8.0 - RESOURCE BASE & AMENITIES

Special environmental and/or resource features: Trinity Bay is a good asset. It is over 1820 feet deep - this is why the Hibernia platform was constructed nearby and towed through this Bay. The area is also said to have good agricultural soils. The best resource is the cod ... if it came back.

Negative features: The forest is a problem. It is sparse and most residents depend on wood for home heating fuel.

Local strategies or projects engaged or planned: There is no town strategic plan in place. There was discussion of the previous Town Council and its reputed confrontational approach to building permits. Apparently the town was left with outstanding legal debts from lawsuits.

The new Zonal system is the province was not seen to be a positive move. It was "letting each town run on their own - survival of the fittest".
