

Blogs as Pedagogical Tools: Why and How?

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Two very simple definitions

- Terminology
 - The language discipline dedicated to the scientific study of the concepts and terms used in specialized languages.

(Translation Bureau, 2011)
- Blog
 - A Web site that contains an online personal journal with reflections, comments, and often hyperlinks provided by the writer.

(Webster Online, 2013)

Why Blogs? The Workplace Reasons

- Ideal links between the University and workplace
 - Portfolios
 - Virtual business cards
 - Online curriculum vitae
- Demonstration of competence
 - Examples of terminological productions
- Illustration of work ethics
 - Presentation of sources and comments

Why Blogs? The Pedagogical Reasons

- Encourage student-student collaboration
 - Build self-confidence
 - Online and classroom team work
 - Mastering of a new medium
 - Cultivate professional ethics
 - Source citations
 - Promote decisional transparency
 - Clear explanations of terminological choices
- Help students to develop a personalised and efficient way of managing content
 - Demonstrate, explicate and illustrate
 - Personal and professional opinions
 - Presentation choices (pictures, videos, etc.)

Why Blogs? The Pedagogical Reasons

- Easy to create, manage and publish
 - Resemble a word processor
- Ideal for formative evaluation
- Easy to assess
 - Track changes in real time
 - Make modifications apparent

Why Blogs? The Original Idea...

- **Theme of the very first course:**
 - The Green Economy

Characteristics of Blogs: It's alive!

- **Can be adapted to a specific target public:**
 - Teachers, students, employers, etc.
- **Allow for multimedia content:**
 - Pictures, videos, illustrations, sound, music, etc.
- **Evolve in response to comments from readers:**
 - Professor, students, friends, family, etc.
- **Are in perpetual development:**
 - Arguments, presentation, etc.

Adapted Learning outcomes

- General learning outcomes: no change
 - Blogs are tools
 - No new terminological knowledge from blogs
- Specific learning outcomes: definite changes
 - They are precise and can be measured
 - New web norms to be assimilated and respected
 - Netiquette
 - Nethics
 - Mastering the technology
 - Full potential of the technology
 - Role and importance in professional practice

Adapted Assessment

- Pertinence of information: 25%
 - Course summary (concise, precise, coherent)
 - Terminological articles, tables, and posts (succinct, well argued, clear)
 - Paratexts (detailed, reasoned, appropriate)
 - Illustrations and videos (pertinent, meaningful, ethical)
 - Sources (reliable, accepted, relevant)

Adapted Assessment

- **Evolution of critical thinking: 10%**
 - Presentation of an opinion or an idea
 - Originality and defense of ideas and thoughts
 - Demonstration of logic
 - Reliability of sources

Adapted Assessment

- **Originality and presentation quality: 15%**
 - **Originality and personalization**
 - **Functionality of presentation**
 - **Usefulness of colours**
 - **Ease of architecture**
 - **Periodic and constant content improvement**

Adapted Assessment

- **Quality of comments: 5%**
 - Respectful
 - Pertinent
 - Constructive
 - Useful
- **Response to comments: 5%**
 - Respectful
 - Taken into account

Adapted Assessment

- **Holistic assessment**
 - **100% means 100%**
- **Evolutive assessment**
 - **Grade changes with time**
