


# Concordia Arrival Checklist

Follow this checklist to settle into Concordia stress-free. Welcome to Montreal! Your adventure starts here.



1

## Register for your courses

You should have already registered for your courses. If you have not, please do so NOW!

2

## Find your ISO advisor

Your ISO advisor to help with everything from settling in and health insurance to your study permits and immigration docs.

3

## Upload your CAQ and/or study permit

You must upload your documents to your Student Centre by the first day of classes, otherwise you risk being de-registered as a Concordia student.

4

## Contact your embassy/consulate

Call to register with your country's consular representative in Canada.

5

## Apply for your Permanent Code

Your permanent code is like a student number used by the Government of Quebec. All Concordia students need one, and you will pay a penalty if you don't have one.

6

## Complete mandatory online training

All new students are required to complete the mandatory IT TAKES ALL OF US Sexual Violence Awareness and Prevention Training within the first 6 weeks of their first term at Concordia University.

7

## Pay your mandatory health insurance

All international students studying in Quebec are required to be covered by Quebec health insurance. Some countries are exempt.

8

## Register for Orientation events

Visit the Concordia University's Orientation page where you can find more information on things to do as a new student, resources and services available to students, and much more!

9

## Get your Concordia Student ID

Upload your own photo and pick up your card.

10

## Get your OPUS public transit card

The Société de transport de Montréal (STM) uses your student ID card photo to create your transit pass, the OPUS card.

11

## Connect to Concordia WiFi

Log onto "Concordia University" WIFI using your Concordia netname and password as the wi-fi username and password.

12

## Open a bank account

To open a bank account, go to the "New Accounts" department at a bank. A bank employee will help you set up the right account for you.

13

## Get mobile plan

There are several telephone companies that provide good mobile phone plans. Explore your options and choose whichever suits your needs best.

14

## Find an internet provider

Explore your internet options and choose whichever suits your needs best.

15

## Get information about driving in Quebec
