### Francine V. Jones Art Conservation Study Scholarship

The Francine V. Jones Art Conservation Study Scholarship is intended to encourage and reward students who are completing a Bachelor in Fine Art (BFA), Master of Art (MA), Master of Fine Art (MFA), or a Master of Design (MDes) degree at the University, and who intend to pursue further studies leading to a career in Art Conservation.

The Scholarship shall be granted through competition to a student who is enrolled in their final term of studies in Fall 2020 or Winter 2021 in the Bachelor or Master of Fine Arts program, in any discipline of study leading to that degree, and is expected to graduate at the Spring 2021 convocation.

Candidates for this scholarship must write a personal statement detailing their interest in and studies to date in Art Conservation, and confirming their intention to pursue further studies in this area at the graduate level leading to an eventual career in this field. Candidates' submissions must be accompanied by two reference letters from Faculty of Fine Arts academic staff who are familiar with the student's interests and intentions in the area of Art Conservation.

Candidate statements and supporting references submitted for this Scholarship competition will be adjudicated by the Faculty of Fine Arts.

*The selected recipient will be invited to apply separately for a possible internship at the Conservation Department of the Montréal Museum of Fine Arts. Please note that availability of an internship position will be determined by the Museum according to its parameters and needs at the time of application.*

To apply for each of the awards listed, students shall provide the following application form and a personal statement, as outlined above.
