How to Apply:

Candidates wishing to apply for this scholarship must submit, along with the application form:

• A one-page statement on why the award is meaningful to them. The statement will demonstrate the applicant's academic interest in, and/or work on a project in the area of energy, energy efficiency, renewable energy, decarbonization, smart cities, or innovation.
