Vincent, Olga and Denis Nicolas-Diniacopoulos Scholarships

The Vincent, Olga and Denis Nicolas-Diniacopoulos Scholarships Program was created in 2000 through the generosity of the late Mrs. Olga Nicolas-Diniacopoulos. Her son, the late Professor Denis Diniacopoulos, taught at Concordia University in the department of Communication Studies for over twenty years, until his retirement in 1996.

These annual scholarships are intended to encourage excellent **full-time students** who are pursuing their undergraduate studies at Concordia University in a Major, Specialization, or Honours, in **Mathematics**. In addition, the purpose of these scholarships is to encourage students who express and can demonstrate an interest in interdisciplinary studies.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must full-time students for the Fall 2022 and Winter 2023 terms and have completed at least one year of full-time studies at Concordia University
- Applicants must have a GPA of at least 3.30
- This award is open to Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents only

Scholarship Value: \$3,000 each

Areas of Study: Major, Specialization or Honours in **Mathematics (2 awards available)**

How to Apply:

In order to be considered for this scholarship, all applicants must submit, along with their application form:

- A 700-word letter of intent expressing their interest in interdisciplinary studies and explaining how receiving this scholarship will help in the pursuit of their studies and the fulfillment of their personal and professional aspirations.
