Garnet Key Entrance Award

The Garnet Key Entrance Award is intended to encourage and reward students pursuing an undergraduate degree program at the University, whose commitment and spirit towards community involvement and academic excellence reflect the values exemplified by Garnet Key Society. In addition to this, the purpose of the endowment is to raise awareness of the Garnet Key Society to students with the hopes that it will create further interest and garner greater competition for students entering the Garnet Key Society.

This award is in perpetuity.

Eligibility Requirements:

- This award is open to new students only, enrolled in any bachelor's degree program.
- Applicants must be studying full-time for the Fall 2023 and Winter 2024 terms.
- Applicants must maintain a GPA of 3.00 or higher.
- Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents and International Students are eligible.

Award Value: One award available valued at \$1,000.00

How to Apply:

Qualified students who wish to be considered for this award must, in addition to their application form, submit:

- A letter of intent in which they will have to demonstrate their civic engagement or community project.
- If you have a Co-Curricular Record at Concordia University, feel free to include a copy with your submission along with the other supporting documents described above.

Essays will be judged on content, as well as the quality of the applicant's reasoning and written expression of ideas.
